About CASA/LA

CASA/LA has been the only organization in Los Angeles County providing court-appointed advocates to youth in foster care, helping these children navigate the trials of the courtroom, and also the trials of a challenged childhood. In FY2022, CASA/LA will serve 1,400 children in LA County’s child welfare system.

CASA/LA’s fiscal year runs from July 1-June 30.

For each \$4,000 contributed, CASA/LA is able to provide life changing advocacy for one year to a child in foster care.

Funds go directly to recruiting, training, and supporting dedicated and diverse CASA volunteers across LA County.
